Conditions of Play and Qualification

1. Conditions of Play

- a) The competition will be played by Stroke Play over 18 holes
- b) The winner (who shall hold the Gilbert Patch Cup for one year) shall be the competitor who returns the lowest net score over 18 holes. In the event of a tie for first place, there will be a sudden death play off to decide the winner. The sequence of holes shall be decided by the Committee.
- c) The winner of the Shropshire Girls Handicap Shield will be the girl competitor with the lowest net 18 hole score
- d) Except as provided in (b) above ties for minor place prizes will be decided on the last 18,9,6,3 & 1 holes in that order, and then decided by reference to the last 6,3 & 1 holes of the first 9 holes of that round.
- e) The winners of The Shropshire Star Junior Team Shield will be the SHUGC golf club team whose players return the best three aggregate nett scores from a team of four. In the event of a tie the teams fourth players score will count and if a tie still exists the shield will be shared

Club team members names must be submitted prior to the start of the morning round.

2. Qualifications

To be eligible to enter a player must:

- a) Submitted an official entry form or copy by the stated entry closing date.
- b) Be under the age of 18 at 00.00 hours on 1st January 2010
- c) Be a boy or girl junior member of a golf club affiliated to the Shropshire & Herefordshire Union of Golf Clubs

3. Junior Beginners with a Junior H/C of 29boys & 37girls to 54.

There will be a competition played directly following the main Junior H/C Championship. The competition will be played over **9 holes** on a shortened course and will be for boys with a h/c of 29-54 and girls with a h/c of 37-54.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Any player whom,in the opinion of the Tournament Committee, during the course of the competition misbehaves by for example: swearing, throwing clubs, vandalising the golf course or clubhouse, disregards county disciplinary rules or the host club rules may be disqualified and debarred from future County events.
- Any player who having entered the competition fails to attend without making reasonable efforts to inform the Tournament Committee may be debarred from future County events.
- All players must hand in their scorecard immediately upon completing their round.
- If any player has any rules query or any other matter which has arisen during play must speak directly to a member of the Tournament Committee.
- Any player who fails to complete the competition with any illness or other reason must inform the Tournament Committee.
- All players should observe without any dissent any instructions and requests from any member of the Tournament Committee.
- Players should demonstrate the highest standard of behaviour and sportsmanship at all times both on and off the course.
- All players should dress in appropriate golfing attire for the golf course and accordingly for the clubhouse.Visible items of jewellery involving body piercing is prohibited.
- The consumption of alcoholic drinks, smoking and use of mobile telephones on the golf course (other than in an emergency) are all prohibited.
