Tournament Conditions of Play and Qualification

- 1. The series of 5 competitions is open to boys under the age of 11 years and girls under the age of 13 on the 1st January 2010. Also this year a new section for boys under 13 on the 1st January 2010 with Handicaps 29 & above.
2. The competitions to be played over 9 holes on courses determined by the Shropshire and Herefordshire Union of Golf Clubs.
3. The Tour Committee reserves the right to change the venue for an event for any reason and agree to notify the competitors accordingly
4. Competitors may only take one prize in each of the events in which they compete.
5. All ties will be decided on a card play-off
6. It is not necessary for a competitor to have been allocated an official CONGU or club playing handicap.
7. Should it become necessary to restrict the number of competitors, entrants will be accepted strictly according to their date of entry.
8. No entries will be accepted by telephone or after the closing date for entries.
9. No refunds will be made unless the withdrawal is received before the date for the entries.
10. The Tour Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without explanation and to adjust the playing handicap of any intending competitors.
11. All disputes shall be decided by the Committee appointed for the purpose of this competition whose decision shall be final.
12. When play is suspended for a dangerous situation (e.g. lightening) the signal will be a prolonged blast on a klaxon. Suspension for any other reason will be signalled by several short blasts on a klaxon. Players will be notified to resume play by two blasts on a klaxon.
13. If you suffer from a condition which may require urgent medical attention (e.g. Asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, heart condition, allergies to bee or wasp stings, etc.), it is important to notify an officer of the Shropshire and Herefordshire Union of Golf Clubs or the Shropshire Ladies County Golf Association accordingly,
14. Caddies (including parents) will be allowed.
15. Local competition rules will be published and distributed for each individual event. These rules may not conform to the Rules of Golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and shall be used for the specific event only.
