

Peewee Tour
Tournament Conditions

Play will generally be from the forward tees over 9 holes

Players may lift clean and place their ball, without penalty anywhere on the course. The ball to be placed within one club's length of its original position not nearer the hole.

Players may take relief from bunkers, and water hazards, and place their ball to the side, and clear of the bunker or water hazard, under a penalty of one stroke. (Players can of course play from the bunker should they wish)

Balls going out of bounds can be placed just within bounds at a position where the ball crossed the boundary for a penalty of one stroke (without going back to play a further ball)

Should the ball be struck into really deep rough/scrub etc then players may move the ball to the nearest position for relief of this condition for a penalty of one shot

Family members or friends may caddy and keep score for the player, but where possible exchange of cards is preferred
