**Competitors must be aware of and conform to the SHUGC General
Conditions applying to County Junior Tournaments (see website).**

1. General

- a) Teams will consist of six players (boys or girls) playing off current handicaps, **with full stroke allowance**. Strokes to be taken according to the Stroke index of the host clubs men's medal card
- b) Maximum handicap allowed will be 28 for boys and 36 for girls
Boys will play from the men's medal tee. Girls will play from the ladies tee. Strokes representing the difference between the men's SSS and the ladies SSS shall be added/deducted to the girls handicap prior to calculation of stroke allowance
- c) Sub-zone league matches will be completed by **1st July**, on dates mutually agreed between the clubs involved. If dates have not been agreed before **31st May**, the Tournament Administrator must be informed.
- d) League match results shall be notified to the Tournament Administrator by post/email within **3 days**. Quarter-finals shall be completed by **29th July** & the result of quarter-final matches shall be notified to the Competition Administrator by **1st August**.
- e) Match games will be played in strict handicap order.
- f) Clubs may enter more than one team.
- g) A player may only represent that Club which he has declared to be his/her "Home" club.(i.e. the club which administers the player's handicap). Players may only represent one team in any one season.
- h) The use of Caddies in all stages of the competition is forbidden.
- i) During the course of a match players can only seek advice from the nominated person who is in charge of the day ie Junior Organiser, Deputy Junior Organiser etc.

2. Qualifying Rounds

- a) Competing clubs will be drawn into four main geographical zones.
Depending on the number of entries: 1) the winner of the zone will qualify for the semi-finals or 2) the zone will be split into 2 sub zones, the winners of which will meet in the quarter finals.
- b) Each club will play each of the other clubs in their group home and away.
The format of each match will be six games of singles matchplay played over 18 holes.
- c) The method of scoring within will be 2 points per win , 1 point per draw.
- d) In the event of an overall tie on match points the result will be determined as stated in the Competition rules covering the Interclub Handicap League Rule 8 as printed in the County Fixture Book.

3. Final Rounds.

- a) The semi-finals and final shall be contested by singles match play at **Telford GC on Wednesday 15th August**. Medals will be awarded to all the competitors.
- b) Each match will consist of six games played over 18 holes . The winners will be determined by games won, or, in the event of a tie on holes won.
- c) In the event of a tie on holes won, the winners will be decided by a "sudden death" play off between one nominated player from each team
- d) The draw to determine semi- final opponents will be made on the morning of Finals.

The Junior League Champions shall represent S & H in the National Junior Club Championships at Woodhall Spa GC, on 25th & 26th August 2012.
