COUNTY JUNIOR BOYS SPRING CUP & CHARLES LEWIS SHIELD
Conditions of Play and Qualification**

1. Conditions of Play

- a) The competition will be played by Stroke Play over 36 holes
- b) The winner (who will be the holder of the Spring Cup for one year) shall be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 36 holes. In the event of a tie for first place over 36 holes there shall be a sudden death play off to decide the winner. The sequence of holes shall be decided by the Committee.
- c) The winners of The Charles Lewis Shield will be the SHUGC golf club whose players return the best four aggregate scores from a maximum team of three.
In the event of a tie a card count back will be used using the best 4 scores.
Club team members names must be submitted prior to the start of the am round.
- d) Except as provided in (b) above ties for minor place prizes will be decided on the last 18,9,6,3 & 1 holes in that order. If a tie still exists it shall be decided by reference to the last 6,3 & 1 holes of the first 9 holes of that round. If a tie still exists the first 18 holes shall be treated in the same way.
- e) No Caddies will be allowed.

2. Qualifications

To be eligible to enter a player must:

- a) Be in possession of a CONGU active handicap not exceeding 12 which can be certified by his Home Club Secretary or Junior Organiser.
- b) Submitted an official entry form by the stated entry closing date.
- c) Be under the age of 18 at 00.00 hours on 1st January 2012

3) Ballot

If the entries exceeds the available tee times, there will be a ballot amongst the higher handicaps to reduce the entry to the appropriate number.

4. Qualification for the County Junior Matchplay Championship

All players 36 hole scores in the Junior Spring Cup will be aggregated with their 36 hole score in the County Junior Championship and the best 16, 72 hole gross scores will qualify for the 2012 County Junior Matchplay Championships to be held at Ludlow GC in September.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

▪Any player whom in the opinion of the Tournament Committee, during the course of the competition, misbehaves by, for example, swearing, throwing clubs, vandalising the golf course or clubhouse, disregards county disciplinary rules or the host club rules may be disqualified and debarred from future County events.

▪Any player who having entered the competition fails to attend without making reasonable efforts to inform the Tournament Committee may be debarred from future County events.

▪All players must hand in their scorecard immediately upon completing their round.

▪If any player has any rules query or any other matter which has arisen during play must speak directly to a member of the Tournament Committee.

▪Any player who fails to complete the competition with any illness or other reason must inform the Tournament Committee.

▪All players should observe without any dissent any instructions and requests from any member of the Tournament Committee.

▪Players should demonstrate the highest standard of behaviour and sportsmanship at all times both on and off the course.

▪All players should dress in appropriate golfing attire for the golf course and accordingly for the clubhouse. The wearing of ear studs are prohibited.

▪The consumption of alcoholic drinks, smoking and use of mobile telephones on the golf course (other than in an emergency) are all prohibited.
