

SPECTATOR CODE & PARENTS RESPONSIBILITIES

Spectator code:-

1. Ensure your mobile phone is switched off.
2. Do not walk too close to players. Please maintain a distance of at least 10yds. (We don't want any allegations that they have been offered advice)
3. Spectators are asked not to walk on any green or tee.
4. Keep to the sides of fairways.
5. As well as not giving advice, do not offer opinions to players on Local Rules & Rules of Golf – leave that to referees / competition officials.
6. Keep your distance from any ball in play.
7. Ball spotting and searching. By all means help, but try to avoid trampling down long grass & do not touch a ball if it might be a player's ball.
8. Do not carry or handle a player's clubs or equipment. (The player may be penalised if you do)
9. For all Junior Competitions, you may not take photographs without obtaining permission from the competition administrator.
10. Please respect all players, parents & officials from opposition teams.

Parents Responsibilities:-

Complete & sign any Parental Consent form.

Be aware of the Safeguarding & Child Protection Policy & Procedures.

Be aware of Players Code of Conduct which has to be signed by the player.

Be aware of the General Conditions that apply for all County Junior Tournaments. (published on website)

Help with any transportation which may be applicable.

Parents should encourage & foster a spirit of fair play in their child. They should not be put under any pressure to play beyond their physical or emotional capabilities.
